**Volunteers are needed at St Joseph RLF** for a few tasks leading up to the all school reunion and the all parish planning meeting in August. Father Chuck would like to hold off hiring any full or part time paid staff members until after we discuss the needs and the direction of the parish of RLF in early August. We no longer have a fulltime janitor so we need to find a way to get the work accomplished until we are able to make an informed decision. The opportunities to be a volunteer and assist the parish mean the work can be done at almost any time, and we will provide the supplies.

- \* This is a one day a week job of about 4 to 5 hours. Sign up for one, two or 8 weeks of work by doing the weekly Church cleaning consisting of dusting, washing the glass entry doors, sweeping and vacuuming, This task could be shared by a family.
- \* Daily extraction of water in the furnace room. This task takes about 1 hour per day. By raising the level of dirt and grass around the church building to provide runoff from the building we hope that we will be having a dry basement. If it works we will no longer need to extract the water. In the mean time we need to extract the water before it causes more damage to the walls. Daily extraction also helps us avoid mold growth.
- \* Carpet cleaning. We are in need of volunteers to clean all the carpeting in the church. This is a task that will require approximately 8 hours of work that can be accomplished over a weeks' time.
- \* Weeding the sidewalk and parking lot; this task will require application of a weed killer like "Round-up" along all the edges and cracks. A onetime project.
- \* The storage shed on the north side of the church could use a good cleaning and re-organization. Broken toys need to be fixed or thrown. The whole area needs to be swept. This is a onetime possibly three hour project.
- \* The school and church basement windows need to be washed inside and out. For someone good with a squeegee this is a simple task. If you will use rags maybe double the time.

The key to having a parish campus we can be proud of is having everyone do a part. Please volunteer. Please consider doing one of these tasks as a family project. Please call Carmen 253-2188 and let her know the task you are available to assist with.
